FOOD4HOPE 2.0 (KLANG VALLEY)

Once again, Malaysian CARE, REACH and CREST came together for FOOD4HOPE due to the extension of MCO 2.0 in Kuala Lumpur, Selangor and 4 other states.

We started with volunteer recruitment as we anticipated that there would be more people in need of food aid this time round. 3 days after the food aid programme was launched on 31 January, approximately 1,500 applications were received from the public.

Based on our record dated on 28 February, 1,027 families have received food packs delivered to them. We thank God and our donors who have contributed to FOOD4HOPE 2.0, be it in the form of financial support or in kind.
